Do you know what disease prevention is and why it's important? Well, we are here to give you that information. Medicare pays for many preventive services to keep you healthy. These preventive services can find health problems early, when treatment works best, and can keep you from getting certain diseases.

Breast Cancer Screening (mammograms) is one of the preventive services that is covered by Medicare.

Who's covered?

Women 40 and older are eligible for a screening mammogram every 12 months. Medicare also covers one baseline mammogram for women between 35-39.

How often is it covered?

Once every 12 months.

Your cost if you have Original Medicare

You pay nothing for the test if the doctor accepts assignment.
